Day 1 North America - Lisbon

Depart for Lisbon from Canada.

Day 2 Lisbon - Porto

Transfer to port after arrival. Embarkation starts at 5 PM. For early or late arrival guests, we will help you to request early embarkation or boxed dinner.

After comfortably settling into your cabins, we'll introduce our crew at a welcome cocktail before dinner. In the evenina, we'll set out on an excursion by coach for both packages to see Porto by night. You will love the old, preserved districts of this city of immense character, classed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Porto is not only a city rich in vestiges from a glorious past, but also the youngspirited, warm capital city of a region marked by its winemaking as well as its closeness to the ocean. During the tour of the historic center, your guide will schedule a stop at the Sao Bento railway station to look at its magnificent azulejos. Return on board by coach.

Day 3 Porto - Regua

Departure by coach from the Villa Nova de Gaia Quay, facing Porto from across the Douro river and the famous Dom Luis I Bridge. Porto, the second largest city in Portugal, stands out from the steep banks of the Douro river with its mixture of grey facades and red tiles interspersed with unusual architectural masterpieces. Its historical center was listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1996. We'll discover The Palácio da Bolsa (Stock Exchange Building), built in 1834 by the city's Commercial Association. lt has remained their headquarters to this day. After climbing up the beautiful granite and marble stairway, we'll visit the former Tribunal Room, the Golden Room and the Arab Room, decorated in the exotic Moorish Revival style. Afterwards, we'll visit the Igreja de São Francisco (Church of Saint Francis), also known as the "Golden Church". We'll cross the Dom Luis I Bridge again back to Villa Nova de Gaia for the visit of a wine cellar. We'll return on board by coach. As the afternoon sun bathes the landscape in a golden glow, we'll set sail through the breathtaking Douro Valley, a region renowned for its picturesque vistas. Enjoy an evening of dancing or time at leisure in Regua tonight.

Day 4 Regua - Vila Real

Depart from Regua and journey to Vila Real, known for its aristocratic palaces and diverse religious architecture. Enjoy a panoramic city tour by coach, followed by a tasting of the local pastry, Cristas de Galo.

Next, explore the enchanting Mateus Palace, an 18th-century marvel with a unique blend of granite and Baroque elements. Marvel at the picturesque garden with box hedges and a spectacular 115-foot cedar tunnel. We'll then return to our ship in Regua, concluding this captivating day of discovery. As the sun sets, prepare for an enchanting evening filled with the passionate rhythms and vibrant energy of Flamenco entertainment, making for a truly memorable night under the stars. Day 5 Barca D'alva - Salamanca

Departure by coach towards Salamanca where you'll meet up with vour auides. Since 1988, the Old Town of Salamanca has been listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. We'll visit the cathedral whose successive extensions created a mixture of styles going from late Gothic to Baroque, including Renaissance. Afterwards, we'll visit one of the world's oldest Universities which first opened in 1218. Also known as "Escuelas Mayores", the University building has a sumptuous gate adorned with the city's most famous design: a frog atop a skull symbolic of the sin of lust being punished after death. You'll enjoy lunch and be free to discover the city on your own. Return on board in Vega de Teron. Enjoy an evening of entertainment.

Day 6 Barca D'Alva – Ferradosa – Pinhao

Today departure from Ferradosa for our excursion along the Porto wine route. We'll discover this incredible vineyard extending over 100 km along the Douro river all the way to the Spanish border. We'll visit San Salvador do Mundo and Sao Joao da Pesqueira, two small towns set among the vineyards in the Rio Torto valley. In Sao Joao da Pesqueira, you will have the opportunity to explore the arcaded main square, the chapel and the white houses with their balconies. You will visit a quinta (wine cellar) to taste the famous Porto*. We'll return on board in Pinhao.

Day 7 Pinhao - Porto

Departure by coach from Regua to Lamego for a guided tour of the city center by coach and on foot. Lamego charmina episcopal and is а commercial town where you'll get to discover the Nossa Senhora dos Remedios Sanctuary. This 18th century church stands out with its white facade dominatina a baroque staircase with 686 steps ending in a shrine built in the rocaille style and adorned with azulejos. The first stone was laid on February 14th, 1750 and gave way to the construction of a massive temple overlooking the city and providing a breathtaking view over the misty mountains of the surrounding landscape. Return on board in Regua.

Day 8 Porto

This morning, enjoy time at leisure in Porto. We'll leave by coach from Porto for Guimarães. With our guide, we'll begin the tour of this university town on foot to discover its historical treasures. We'll get the chance to discover the Nossa Senhora de Oliveira Church (outdoors), the most important religious building in the city. The medieval heart of Guimarães is a labyrinth of lanes and picturesque plazas framed by 14th-century buildings. We'll continue on to the Palace of the Dukes of Braganza, a medieval estate and former residence of the first Dukes of Braganza with striking architecture. Return on board in Porto. Enjoy an evening of traditional folk entertainment. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Next, view the treasured 16th century Belem Tower and the Jeronimos Monastery, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Afterwards, visit the Cathedral of eniov the Lisbon and eleaant Liberdade Avenue. Then transfer to the hotel.


